A cherry, 4 ins. diam., bears S.67°W., 18 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 9 W S 2 B T.

An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears N.58°W., 332 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 9 W S 35 B T.

East, on true line, bet. secs. 36 and 1.

Var. 20°8'E.

Descend.

- 3.00 A gulch, course S.; begin ascent.
- 7.75 Top of spur, bears E. & W.; begin descent.
- 12.00 A canyon, course SE.; begin ascent.
- 13.40 Top of ridge, bears SE. & NW.
- 24.50 A landslide.
- 28.50 Gold Creek, 15 lks. wide, course S.; about 100 lks. N. from here are some gold diggings, the mineral appears to me like cement stone.
- Begin moderate ascent.
- 34.10 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend S. slope.
- 40.00 Set a post, 4 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S on N. face; from which
 - A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.13½°E., 10 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.
 - A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.29°W., 29 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.
- Along N. slope of mountain.
- 52.90 A gulch, course N. Mount Roman Nose bears N.25°W. Begin ascent.
- 54.40 Top of rise.
- 56.20 A gulch, course N. -40
- 60.00 Top of rise. +30
- 61.75 A gulch, course N. -40
- 67.00 Change to S. slope.
