 S.89°41'E., on random line, bet. secs. 14 and 23.
 Va.19°E.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.

80.30 Intersect E. bdy. of Sec., 25 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 13,
 14, 23, and 24.

Thence I run

N.89°52'W., on true line, bet. secs. 14 and 23.
 Va.19°E.

40.15 Along top of ridge, course E.

Set post, 4 ft. long, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground,
 for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S on N. face; from which a
 Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.60°E., dist. 71 lks.,
 marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.
 Fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N.23°E., dist. 80 lks.,
 marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.

76.00 Canyon, course SW.

80.30 The cor. to secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23.

From the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23, I run
 North 2'W., on line between secs. 14 and 15.
 Va.19°E.

18.00 Top of hill, course NW.; descend.
