marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 21 B T.

Fir, 17 ins. diam., bears S.76°E., dist. 9 lks.,

marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 27 B T.

Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.44°E., dist. 62 lks.,

marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 22 B T.
