CHAINS

Set post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face; from which a Maple, 12 ins. diam., bears N.17°W., dist. 72 lks., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Alder, 6 ins. diam., bears S.27°W., dist. 43 lks., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Over a low ridge to

60.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend.

80.20 Cor. to secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16.

Sept. 29, 1892.

From cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16, I run

North 2°W., on line, bet. secs. 9 and 10.

Va.19°E.

Descend.

17.00 Branch, 3 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend.

40.00 High ridge, course NE.

Set post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which a Chittem, 5 ins. diam., bears N.27°W., dist. 27 lks., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.16°E., dist. 73 lks., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

49.00 Spur of hill; descend.

61.00 Canyon, course SW.; ascend.

76.00 Top of ridge, course NE.; descend.

80.00 On N. slope of hill.

Set post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10, marked T 20 S Sec 3 on NE., R 10 W Sec 10 on SE., Sec 9 on SW., Sec 4 on NW. faces, with 5 notches on S. and 3 on E. edges; from which a

Hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears N.24°E., dist. 93 lks., marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 3 B T.

Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.36°E., dist. 72 lks.,
