CHAINS

S.89°45'E., 3.00 chs.; I continued this line N.89°45'W. and intersect west bdy. line at the cor. of secs. 24, 25, 19, and 30, which is a post, 2½ ft. above ground, firmly set in the ground, marked T 20 S Sec 19 on NE., R 10 W Sec 30 on SE., R 11 W Sec 25 on SW., Sec 24 on NW. faces, with 2 notches on S. & 4 notches on N. edges; from which

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.76°E., 14 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 19 B T.

Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.3°E., 105 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 30 B T.

Fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S.61½°W., 44 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W Sec 25 B T.

Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.2°W., 107 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W Sec 24 B T.
