Temporary cor. set by me Sept. 1892 at the end of 80.00 chs. on N. bdy. of Sec. 18 bears N.89°40'E., 3.50 chs.; I continued this line S.89°41'W. and at point of intersection

I set a sandstone, 24x20x10 ins., marked C C with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N. edges, for closing cor. to secs. 7 and 18; from which an

Alder, 6 ins. diam., bears N.46°E., 23 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 7 B T.

Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.10°E., 16 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 18 B T.

Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.36°W., 44 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 7 & 18 C C B T.

North on West bdy. of Sec. 7.

Descend steep hill.

A chittom tree, 3 ins. diam., bears N.27°E., 24 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 7 B T.

Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.71½°E., 15 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 10 W Sec 18 B T.

Cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears S.34½°W., 63 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W Sec 13 B T.

A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N.82°W., 22 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W Sec 12 B T.

I destroyed all marks on this cor. relating to R. 10 W.

17.50 Stream, 2 lks. wide, c East.

28.50 Spur, c SE.; along E. slope.

36.50 Ridge, c E. & W.; descend.
