

Retracement of Portion East Bdy., T. 19 S., R. 10 W.

Ravine, course W.; ascend 60 ft. on N. slope to

27.93

Fall 25 lks. E. of the closing cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 S., R. 9 W., which is a chittem, 6 ins. diam., marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, except that the SE. bearing tree is dead. I take new bearing tree.

From the corner

(Old bearing tree) A chittem, 6 ins. diam., bears N.20°E., 40 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 9 W S 31 B T.

(New bearing tree) A chittem, 4 ins. diam., bears S.38°E., 10 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 9 W S 6 C C B T.

The true bearing and length of this line, from the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., is S.0°31'W., 27.93 chs..

From the closing Tp. cor.

South retracing E. bdy. of sec. 36.

Ascend 25 ft. on NW. slope.

1.40 Spur, slopes W.; descend 90 ft. on S. slope.

3.75 Ravine, course W.; ascend 160 ft. on N. slope.

7.87 On spur, sloping W.; fall 7 lks. E. of the cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 S., R. 10 W., heretofore described.

The true bearing and length of this line, from the closing Tp. cor. is S.0°31'W., 7.87 chs.
