A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.20°W., 69 lks. dist.,

marked T 20 S R 9 W S 35 B T.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.68°W., 17 lks. dist.,

marked T 20 S R 9 W S 26 B T.

and raised a mound of stone, 1½ ft. high and 2 ft. base alongside.

Sept. 7th, 1891.

At 7½ a.m., Sept. 8th, I find the last line run bears N.20°4'W.

Ascend S. slope of burnt timber spur.

8.00 Begin descent of a very rocky S. slope.

12.00 Enter scattering green fir timber.

28.00 Enter clearing.

37.50 Compton's barn bears S., about 2.00 chs. dist.

40.17 Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 18 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S on N. face; from which

A maple, 36 ins. dia., bears S.26½°W., 117 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

A fir, 30 ins. dia., bears N.79°E., 545 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

40.92 Compton's house.

42.00 A branch, 5 lks. wide, course S.; leave clearing.
