

Subdivisions of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

A barberry, 8 ins. diam., bears S.45°E., 4 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 9 W S 16 B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.36°W., 267 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 9 W S 17 B T.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.88°W., 155 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 9 W S 8 B T.

Sept. 18th, 1891.

N.89°21'W., on a random line, bet. secs. 17 and 8.  
Var.20°8'E.

40.00 Set temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.44 Intersect N. and S. line, 50 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17, and 18.

Thence I run

S.89°42 $\frac{1}{2}$ 'E., on true line, bet. secs. 17 and 8.  
Var.20°2'E.

Ascend N. slope.

2.50 Change ascent to a W. slope, very steep. +75

11.00 Top of a dividing ridge, bears N. & S.; begin descent. +350

28.25 Johnson Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S.; begin steep ascent. -400

40.22 Set a post, 4 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face; from which

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.10°E., 19 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.88°W., 21 lks. dist.

This cor. stands near the top of ascent on S. slope.

Descend along S. slope.

48.00 Change to descent of E. slope.

50.25 A canyon, course S.; begin ascent of W. slope; a branch, -100 course SW., 2 lks. wide, is south about 3 chs.

56.50 Johnson Creek, 5 lks. wide, course SW.; begin very steep ascent.

60.00 Change to ascent of S. slope.

78.50 Top of dividing ridge, bears SW. and NE.; timber mostly +550
