

Subdivisions of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

66.35 West branch, 60 lks. wide, course S.

80.00 The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28.

Sept. 20th, 1891.

From the cor. to secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, which is a post, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a mound of decayed rock around, marked T 20 S S 22 on NE., R 9 W S 27 on SE., S 28 on SW., S 21 on NW. faces, with 2 notches on S. and 3 notches on E. edges; from which
 A fir, (now dead) 42 in. dia., bears S.72 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 111 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 9 W S 27 B T.

I run

N.0°2'E., bet. secs. 21 and 22.

Va.20°8'E.

Steep descent through small firs.

3.20 A canyon and branch, 3 lks. wide, course NW.; begin steep ascent. -100

7.40 Top of burnt timber flat, bears E. +80

10.25 A canyon & branch, 1 lk. wide, course W. -85

11.50 Top of bluff; descend the same on W. slope. +70

15.75 Foot of bluff, close to West branch; ascend W. slope. -75

26.00 Enter green fir timber.

39.75 Top of spur, bears E. & W.; begin descent. -280

40.00 Set a post, 48 ins. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.62°W., 10 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.39 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 23 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Keep on descending N. slope.

45.80 A canyon & branch, 2 lks. wide, course NW. -220

51.60 A branch, 5 lks. wide, course NW. -20

55.00 Enter a timber flat, bears E. & W.

64.10 Wroe's house bears S.47°W.; begin ascent of SW. slope.
