- 1.25 Leave bottom; begin ascent.
- 3.00 Top of ridge, bears E. & W. +75
- 4.50 Begin descent of a bluff.
- 4.75 West branch, 75 lks. wide, course W.; begin ascent of a -55
cleared timber flat.
- Th. Moore house bears W., about 3.50 chs.
- 15.00 Th. Moore's house bears S.26°W. Leave clearing; enter +60
green fir timber flat, bears E. & W.
- 27.75 Begin steep ascent.
- 30.25 Top of spur, bears NW. and SE. +30
- 32.60 A canyon, course SE. +50
- 40.00 Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 18 ins. in the +170
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from
which
 A fir, 24 ins. dia., bears N.31°E., 16 lks. dist.,
 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
 A dogwood, 6 ins. dia., bears S.74°W., 36 lks. dist.,
 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- Keep ascending.
- 43.00 Top of ridge, bears E. & W.; begin descent. +120
- 55.50 A canyon, course E.; begin ascent. -240
- 62.25 Top of spur, bears SE. & NW.; begin descent. +175
- 70.75 A canyon, course SE. -220
- 80.00 A fir, 20 ins. in dia., which I marked T 20 S S 2 on NE.,
R 9 W S 11 on SE., S 10 on SW., S 3 on NW. sides, with
5 notches on S. and 2 notches on E. sides, for cor. to
secs. 2, 3, 10 & 11; from which
 A fir, 30 ins. dia., bears N.73°E., 22 lks. dist.,
 marked T 20 S R 9 W S 2 B T.
 A fir, 24 ins. dia., bears S.20 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 15 lks. dist.,
 marked T 20 S R 9 W S 11 B T.
