8.00	Top of spur, bears N. & S.; begin descent.	+120
13.50	A canyon, bears N.30°W.; begin ascent of N. slope.	-80
27.25	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course NW.	+60
40.00	Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 18 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face; from which <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A vinemaple, 3 ins. dia., bears S.47°E., 26 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A vinemaple, 3 ins. dia., bears N.63°E., 42 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p> Along N. slope.	
44.00	Top of ridge, dividing waters of the West branch from those of the Twin Sisters, bears NW. & SE.; begin descent.	+330
56.50	A branch, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; begin ascent.	-150
72.00	Top of spur, bears E. & W.	+160
88.50	A canyon, course NE.	-120
93.25	Top of spur, bears NE. & SW.	-100
99.00	Intersect East boundary of township, 175 lks. south of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 12 and 7, which is a post, 4 ins. square, 3 ft. above ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A maple, 20 ins. dia., bears N.40°W., 20 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A maple, 20 ins. dia., bears N.72°E., 36 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p> For closing cor. to secs. 12 and 13, I set a sandstone, 8x8x8 ins., 5 ins. in the ground, marked C C with 2 notches on N. and 4 notches on S. edges; and raised a mound of stone, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 2 ft. base, alongside. Pits impracticable.
