- 61.10 Ravine, course NW.; ascend 130 ft. on NE. slope.
- 68.00 Spur, slopes N.; descend 20 ft. on NW. slope.
- 70.50 Ravine, course NE.; ascend 435 ft. on E. slope.
- 81.66 Ridge, bears N. and S.; descend 340 ft. on NW. slope.
- 90.05 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SW.
- 90.64 Intersect W. bdy. of the Tp., 12.03 chs. N.10°17'W. of cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 20 S., R. 10 W., and set closing cor., heretofore described.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8, heretofore described,

N.0°02'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 5 and 6.

- 24.60 Ravine, course SW.; ascend 435 ft. on SW. slope.
- 35.21 Spur, slopes W.; descend 45 ft. on NW. slope.
- 38.00 Draw, course W.; ascend 20 ft. on SW. slope.
- 39.40 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked
