- A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.40½°E., 24 lks. dist. marked T 19 S R 8 W S 31 B T.
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- N. on W. boundary of Sec. 30.
- Va. observed at 7 a.m. 20°36'E.
- 5.00 Descend gently.
- 13.50 Enter bottom.
- 14.10 Stream, 20 lks. wide, c West.
- 16.00 A fir, 60 ins. diam.
- 17.50 Rise gently.
- 22.00 Var. observed at 8 a.m. 20°30'E.
- 40.00 Set post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S on W. face; from which
- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.20½°W., 66 lks. dist. marked ¼ S B T.
- A maple, 16 ins. diam., brs. N.33½°E. Distance omitted.
- 41.38 A fir, 36 ins. diam.
- 58.00 Top of gentle ascent, 600 ft. up; descend very steep.
- 68.90 Fir, 48 ins. diam.
- 71.05 A hollow, c E., 450 ft. down.
- 76.00 Stream, 4 lks. wide, c E.; ascend very steep.
- 80.00 A maple, 7 ins. diam., 150 ft. up, which I mark for cor.
