9.50	Head of ravine, course S.; ascend 50 ft. to
17.00	Summit of ridge, bears NW. and SE.; descend along N. slope, over spurs and ravines.
38.00	Old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears S., 14.00 chs. dist.; I destroy it.
39.95	A fir, 12 ins. diam. for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 on N. and 9 on S. sides; from which A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.33°E., 26 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.24°W., 8 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
45.00	Joe Slemmon's cabin bears N.7°E., about 25.00 chs. dist.
70.00	Pass to SE. slope; descend 150 ft. to
77.00	Ravine, course SE.; ascend 50 ft. to
79.90	The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10.
From the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, on S. bdy. of Tp. I run N.0°03'E., bet. secs. 34 and 35. Descend through small timber and dense undergrowth.	
23.00	Creek, 3 lks. wide, 200 ft. below sec. cor., course NE.; ascend 200 ft. to

40.00	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., established on former survey, which is a cherry tree, 9 ins. diam., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 on W. and 35 on E. sides; from which A cedar, 24 ins. diam., bears N.8°W., 24 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A maple, 6 ins. diam., bears N.59°E., 24 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
63.00	Top of spur, 250 ft. above creek, bears NE.; descend 100 ft. to
66.10	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE.; ascend 150 ft. to
71.50	Top of spur, bears NE.; descend.
80.00	The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35, established on former survey, which is an alder tree, 12 ins. diam.,
