North between sections 26 & 27.

V.20°E.

Along mountain top.

40.00 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for gr. sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on W. face; from which

Fir, 12 ins. dia., bears S.42°W., 15 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

Fir, 10 ins. dia., bears N.15°E., 95 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. B T.

80.00 Set post, 6 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, in mound of stone, 18 ins. high, 5 ft. sqr. base, for cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26 & 27, marked T 21 S S 23 on NE., R 8 W S 26 on SE., S 27 on SW., S 22 on NW. face, with 2 notches on S. & E. edges. No witness trees.

April 26th.

East, on random line, between secs. 23 & 26.

V.20°E.

40.00 Set temp. gr. sec. cor.

79.90 Intersect N. & S. line, 20 lks. South of cor. to secs. 23, 24, 25 & 26; thence

S.89°51' West, on true line, between secs. 23 & 26.

V.20°E.

Descend mountain.

19.00 Cross branch, flows South; ascend.

39.95 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, in mound of rock, 18 ins. high, 3 ft. sqr. at base, for gr. sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N. face. No witness trees.

Still ascend.

79.90 The cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26 & 27.

North between secs. 22 & 23.
