- 43.00 Top of ridge; descend.

- Fir, 40 ins. dia., bears N.56°E., 33 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 8 W S 15 B T.
- Cedar, 24 ins. dia., bears S.43°E., 21 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 8 W S 22 B T.
- Fir, 48 ins. dia., bears S.60°W., 13 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 8 W S 21 B T.
- Cedar, 40 ins. dia., bears N.27°W., 38 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 8 W S 16 B T.
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- East, on random line, between secs. 15 & 22.
- V.20°E.
- 40.00 Set temp. gr. sec. cor.
- 79.92 Intersect N. & S. line, 50 lks. South of cor. to secs. 14, 15, 22 & 23.
- S.89°39' West, on true line, between secs. 15 & 22.
- Ascend.
- 18.00 On mountain top.
- 39.96 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, in mound of stone, 18
