CHAINS

North between secs. 29 & 30.

V.20°E.

Descend.

19.00 Ascend mountain.

40.00 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for qr. sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face. No witness trees. Raised mound of stone alongside on mountain top.

80.00 Set post, 6 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for cor. to secs. 19, 20, 29 & 30, marked T 20 S S 20 on NE., R 8 W S 29 on SE., S 30 on SW., S 19 on NW. face, with 2 notches on S. & 5 on E. edges; from which

Fir, 10 ins. dia., bears N.53°E., 20 lks. dist.,
marked T 20 S R 8 W S 20 B T.

Fir, 10 ins. dia., bears S.55°E., 25 lks. dist.,
marked T 20 S R 8 W S 29 B T.

Fir, 8 ins. dia., bears S.42°W., 21 lks. dist.,
marked T 20 S R 8 W S 30 B T.

Fir, 6 ins. dia., bears N.34°W., 14 lks. dist.,
marked T 20 S R 8 W S 19 B T.

East, on random line, between secs. 20 & 29.

V.20°E.

40.00 Set temp. qr. sec. cor.

80.20 Intersect N. & S. line, 16 lks. South of cor. to secs.
20, 21, 28 & 29; thence

S.89°53' West, on true line, between secs. 20 & 29.

Ascend mountain.

30.00 Descend.

40.10 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for qr. sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face; from which

Hemlock, 5 ins. dia., bears S.10°E., 17 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
