Fir, 24 ins. dia., bears S.72°E., 30 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 8 W S 17 B T.

Fir, 24 ins. dia., bears S.2°W., 63 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 8 W S 18 B T.

Fir, 30 ins. dia., bears N.36°E., 128 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 8 W S 8 B T.

Alder, 12 ins. dia., bears N.59°W., 74 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 8 W S 7 B T.

East, on random line, between secs. 8 & 17.

V.20 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E.

40.00 Set temp. qr. sec. cor.

80.10 Intersect N. & S. line, 15 lks. South of cor. to secs. 8, 9, 16 & 17.

S.89°54'West, on true line, between secs. 8 & 17.

Along bottom.

5.00 North branch Twin Sisters, flows N.; ascend.

34.00 Top of hill; descend.

40.05 Set post, 6 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for qr. sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face; from which

Hemlock, 18 ins. dia., bears N.20°E., 39 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Maple, 20 ins. dia., bears S.26°E., 34 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

45.00 Stream, 40 lks. wide, flows South.

64.00 Stream, 40 lks. wide, flows North.

74.50 Stream, 40 lks. wide, flows South.

80.10 The cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17 & 18.
