6 notches on N., W. & S. edges; from which

A fir, 8 ins. dia., bears N.38°E., 17 lks. dist.,
marked T 20 S R 7 W S 6 B T.

A fir, 8 ins. dia., bears S.32°W., 5 lks. dist.,
marked T 20 S R 8 W S 1 B T.

A fir, 4 ins. dia., bears N.27°W., 22 lks. dist.,
marked T 19 S R 8 W S 36 B T.

Thence I run

N. on E. bdy. of Sec. 36.

Va. observed 2 p.m. 20°30'E.

Ascend steep very brushy hillside, fir timber, mostly
dead.

16.90 Stream, 2 lks. wide, c SE.

20.32 An old post marked as closing cor. for T. 20 S., R. 8 W.
brs. East 20 lks. Old line of blazes run to this from
E. & S.

27.50 Top of steep ascent, 700 ft. above corner; thence over
rolling table land in fine live timber, mostly fir.

40.00 Set post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground,
for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which
A fir, 18 ins. dia., bears S.60°W., 26 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A fir, 12 ins. dia., bears S.45 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 23 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

47.50 Leave table land; descend rapidly in dead timber, dense
brush & briars.

50.00 Hollow, course NE.; thence along steep E. side of ridge,
very brushy.

69.00 Cross top of said ridge, c N.10°E.; thence along W. side
of same.

80.00 At point on W. slope of ridge near top, about 350 ft.
below table land.

Set post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground, for
cor. to secs. 36 & 25, marked T 19 S R 8 W S 25 on NW.,
T 19 S R 8 W S 36 on SW. faces, with 5 notches on N.
