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| 18.50 | Bottom of canyon, c N., with very little water in pools about 600 ft. below corner. Ascend very steep. |
| 26.00 | Top of spur, c N., about 300 ft. above canyon; descend very steep. |
| 33.40 | Bottom of canyon, 200 ft. below spur. |
| 39.62 $\frac{1}{2}$ | Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face; from which An alder, 12 ins. diam., brs. S.67°W., 52 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 14 ins. diam., brs. N.88°E., 12 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. Thence across little narrow bottom. |
| 40.40 | Ascend along steep N. slope. |
| 45.75 | Into hollow, c NE.; ascend steep. |
| 54.50 | Top of ridge, c N.20°W. and S.20°E., 450 ft. above little bottom; thence descend gently across table land. |
| 61.50 | To top of big slide; thence descend very steep across slide. |
| 79.25 | To cor. to secs. 25, 26, 35 & 36. |

| 5.00 | Enter green timber; thence ascend along West slope gently. |
| 40.00 | Set post, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which A fir, 60 ins. diam., brs. N.20 $\frac{3}{4}$ °E., 73 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A chinquapin, 10 ins. diam., brs. N.88°W., 8 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. Continue to ascend. |
| 40.75 | Onto ridge, divide bet. Siuslaw and Esmond Creek, c NW. and SE., about 550 ft. above creek; thence in dead timber, dense undergrowth of briars and hazel. Va. observed at 3:30 p.m. 20°29'E. |
