$\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which
A cedar, 10 ins. diam., brs. N. $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 110 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A maple, 16 ins. diam., bears S. $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 15 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Enter heavy green timber.

44.80 Stream, 1 lk. wide, c W.

50.00 Stream, 4 lks. wide, c S. 20° W., the one whose hollow we
have been following up; continue up west side of same.

55.25 Cedar, 15 ins. diam.

57.75 Stream, 1 lk. wide, c S. 80° E.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 72 lks. dist.,
marked T 19 S R 8 W S 21 B T.
