	Va. at 11:30 a.m. 20°30'E.
	Descend, gently, along a spur.
15.00	Enter bottom of Esmond Creek, 350 ft. down.
20.70	A dry channel, c N.
22.30	Trail, N. & S.
22.35	Fir, 60 ins. diam.
24.60	Road, c NE. & SW.
25.30	Esmond Creek, 30 lks. wide, c NE.
28.50	Leave bottom; ascend.
32.00	Onto bench sloping NW.
39.61	Set post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face; from which A fir, 6 ins. dia., bears S.31 $\frac{3}{4}$ °E., 74 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 8 ins. diam., brs. N.5 $\frac{3}{4}$ °W., 84 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
48.50	Hollow, c N.; continue to ascend.
51.00	Top of spur, c N.; descend.
55.00	Bottom of ravine, c N.; rise along N. side of a ridge.
69.50	Top of high ridge, c N. & S., about 600 ft. above bottom; descend very steep.
76.20	Into slide in ravine, c N.60°W., 250 ft. below ridge; descend a little along N. slope.
79.22	To cor. to secs. 8, 9, 16 & 17.
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	N.4'W., bet. secs. 8 & 9.
	Va. observed 20°27'E. at 2.p.m.
	Descend steep.
1.50	Into slide canyon; ascend very steep.
8.00	Top of ascent on very steep West slope. Va. observed at 2:30 p.m. 20°29'E.
