97.20	Intersect W. boundary of Tp., 40 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 30 & 19; thence $S.89^{\circ}1'E.$, on true line, bet. secs, 19 & 30. Va. $20^{\circ}25'E.$ at 5 p.m. Descend gradually on table land.
4.20	Stream, 6 lks. wide, c S.
8.75	Stream, 2 lks. wide, c S.
15.00	Fir, 60 ins. dia., on brow of hill; descend.
20.75	Enter bottom, about 200 ft. below cor.
21.25	Stream, 20 lks. wide, c S.
