CHAINS

$\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which
A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.46 $\frac{2}{3}$ °E., 179 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

No trees in limits on W. side; dug pits, 18x18x12
ins., W. of post, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist.; and raised a mound of
earth, 2 ft. high, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

57.00 Leave rolling country; descend steep.

61.75 Stream, 8 lks. wide, c E., in rocky slide; ascend steep
through thick briars and fern.

80.00 Set post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground, for
cor. to secs. 17, 18, 7 & 8, marked T 19 S S 8 on NE.,
R 8 W S 17 on SE., S 18 on SW., S 7 on NW. faces, with
5 notches on E. and 4 notches on S. edges; from which
A fir, 18 ins. dia., bears N.10°E., 206 lks. dist.,
marked T 19 S R 8 W S 8 B T.

A fir, 48 ins. dia., bears S.29 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 50 lks. dist.,
marked T 19 S R 8 W S 17 B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.82 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 75 lks. dist.,
marked T 19 S R 8 W S 18 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. dia., bears N.8 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W., 168 lks. dist.,
marked T 19 S R 8 W S 7 B T.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

79.44 Intersect N. & S. line, 30 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 8, 9,
16 & 17; thence

N.89°W., on true line, bet. secs. 8 & 17.

Va.20°31' at 10:30 a.m.

Descend very steep in deadening.

2.00 Hollow, c NW.; thence in dense briars.

7.50 Stream, 4 lks. wide, c S.10°W., 180 ft. below corner;
ascend.

18.25 Stream, 3 lks. wide, c S.20°E., 250 ft. up.
