- 40.00 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for qr. sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which
- A fir, 30 ins. dia., bears N.45°W., 29 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- A fir, 30 ins. dia., bears N.68°E., 14 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- 70.00 Cross gulch, course E.; ascend.
- 80.00 Set post, 6 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, in ground 24 ins.; raised mound of rocks alongside, for cor. to secs. 18, 19, 13 & 24, marked T 21 S S 18 on NE., R 6 W S 19 on SE., R 7 W S 24 on SW., S 13 on NW. face, with 3 notches on S. & 3 on N. face; from which

- A stub, 30 ins. dia., bears S.20°W., 80 lks. dist., marked T 21 S R 7 W S 24 B T.
- Mound of rocks bears N.50°W., 25 lks. dist.
