- 40.00 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for qr. sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on North face; from which

- A fir, 40 ins. dia., bears N.20°W., 72 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 7 W S 34 B T.
- A fir, 36 ins. dia., bears S.45°W., 47 lks. dist., marked T 21 S R 7 W S 4 B T.

- 40.00 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, 24 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on North face; from which
- A fir, 24 ins. dia., bears N.13°W., 44 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
