- 77.70 Smith River, trail, c along river.
- 80.00 Set post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 27, 28, 33 & 34, marked T 20 S S 27 on NE., R 7 W S 34 on SE., S 33 on SW., S 28 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on S. & 3 notches on E. edges; from which
- A fir, 48 ins. dia., bears N.42°E., 14 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 7 W S 27 B T.
- A chittem, 4 ins. dia., bears S.35°E., 32 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 7 W S 34 B T.
- A V. maple, 4 ins. dia., bears S.11½°W., 28 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 7 W S 33 B T.
- A chittem, 4 ins. dia., bears N.43°W., 33 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 7 W S 28 B T.

- 40.00 Set temporary ¼ sec. cor.
- 80.55 Intersect N. & S. line at the cor. to secs. 26, 27, 34 & 35.

- 5.55 Smith River trail, c N. & S. along river.
- 16.30 Smith River, 60 lks. wide, c N.40°E.
- 26.45 Smith River, 60 lks. wide, c S.80°W.
Enter Mrs. Jennette Palmer's meadow.
- 30.70 Fir on line, 84 ins. dia., with 2 notches on N. & S. sides.
- 36.05 Mrs. Palmer's house bears S., 20 lks. dist.
- 40.27 Set a cedar post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 2 ft. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S on N. face; from which
