15.50 Top of hill; descend.

49.30 Cross branch, 2 lks., flows SE.

58.30 Cross branch, 8 lks., flows East; ascend mountain.

face; from whichFir, 36 ins. dia., bears N.45°W., 20 lks. dist.,
