Laurel, 16 ins. dia., bears N.76°W., 50 lks. dist.,

71.50 Cross trail to Elkton, N.10°W.  
80.00 A fir, 10 ins. dia., for cor. to secs. 33, 34, 28 & 27, marked T 21 S S 27 on NE., R 7 W S 34 on SE., S 33 on SW., S 28 on NW. face, with 3 notches on E. & 1 on S. edges; from which  
Fir, 10 ins. dia., bears N.40°E., 33 lks. dist.,  
marked T 21 S R 7 W S 27 B T.  
Fir, 20 ins. dia., bears N.64°W., 6 lks. dist.,  
marked T 21 S R 7 W S 28 B T.
