Cedar, 18 ins. dia., bears S.86°W., 32 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 7 W S 6 B T.

40.00 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, 24 ins. in ground, for qr. sec. cor., marked ¼ S on W. face; from which Fir, 40 ins. dia., bears S.70°W., 33 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

Cedar, 30 ins. dia., bears N.41°E., 200 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

71.00 Ridge; descend 12°.

80.00 Set post, 6 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for cor. to secs. 29, 30, 31 & 32, marked T 21 S S 29 on NE., R 7 W S 32 on SE., S 31 on SW., S 30 on NW. face, with 5 notches on E. and 1 on S. edges; from which

Fir, 36 ins. dia., bears N.14°W., 64 lks. dist., marked T 21 S R 7 W S 30 B T.

Fir, 18 ins. dia., bears N.27°E., 58 lks. dist., marked T 21 S R 7 W S 29 B T.
