Survey by Wm. P. Wright under Contract No. 514 dated  
August 27, 1884.

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On account of fire and the lapse of time I found it impossible to close upon the East and West boundaries because of the absence of the corners & witness trees and so re-run the East and South boundaries.

Survey commenced Sept. 25, 1884.

I started from the cor. to secs. 19, 24, 25 & 30, which post I found much decayed. Reestablished the same by setting a post, 6 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, marked T 21 S S 19 on NE., R 5 W S 30 on SE., R 6 W S 25 on SW., S 24 on NW. face, with 2 notches in S. & 4 in N. edge; from which old witness trees:

Fir, 16 ins. dia., bears N. 65° E., 18 lks. dist.,  
marked T 21 S R 5 W S 19 B T.

Fir, 8 ins. dia., bears S. 35° E., 6 lks. dist.,  
marked T 21 S R 5 W S 30 B T.

Fir, 12 ins. dia., bears N. 41° W., 6 lks. dist.,  
marked T 21 S R 6 W S 24 B T.
