## CHAINS

Ascend 15°.

11.50 Descend 16°.

23.00 On bottom.

32.75 Smith River, 20 lks., flows West.

37.50 Leave timber; enter burn.

40.00 Set post, 4 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for gr. sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on W. face; from which

Fir, 24 ins. dia., bears N.60°W., 53 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

Fir, 36 ins. dia., bears S.56°E., 33 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

Ascend 15°.

59.00 Cross spur; descend 17°.

81.60 Intersect North boundary of Town., 285 lks. East of cor. to secs. 35 & 36. Found post standing, marked T 20 S S 36 on NE., S 1 on SE., R 6 W S 2 on SW., S 35 on NW. face, and but one witness tree:

Fir, 24 ins. dia., bears S.45°E., 38 lks. dist.,  
marked T 21 S R 6 W S 1 B T.

I set closing cor. to secs. 1 & 2 by setting post, 6 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, marked T 20 S S 36 on NE., R 6 W S 1 C C on SE., S 2 C C on SW. face, with 5 notches on W. and 1 on E. edge; from which

Fir, 10 ins. dia., bears N.59°W., 15 lks. dist.,  
marked T 20 S R 6 W S 36 B T.

Fir, 10 ins. dia., bears S.80°W., 24 lks. dist.,  
marked T 21 S R 6 W S 2 C C B T.

Fir, 8 ins. dia., bears S.86°E., 75 lks. dist.,  
marked T 21 S R 6 W S 1 C C B T.

Oct. 1st, 1884.

From the cor. to secs. 3<sup>4</sup>, 35, 2 & 3, on south bound. of Town.
