80.00 Set post, 6 ins. dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground, for cor. to secs. 14, 15, 22 &amp; 23, marked T 21 S S 14 on NE., R 6 W S 23 on SE., S 22 on SW., S 15 on NW. face, with 3 notches on S. &amp; 2 on E. edges; from which.

marked T 21 S R 6 W S 22 B T.Fir, 60 ins. dia., bears N.57°W., 97 lks. dist.,
