40.00 Set post 4 ins. diam., 4 ft. long with marked stone 12 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W face from which:

Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.42*E., 29 lks. dist.,

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T

Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.16*W., 42 lks, dist.,

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T

60.00 Top of Mountain descend sloping NW

80.00 Set post 6 ins. diam., 4 ft. long with marked stone 12 ins. in ground for cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 & 12, marked T 21 S, S 1 on NE, R 8 W, S 12 on SE, S 11 on SW, S 2 on NW face with one notch on E and 5 on S edge from which:

Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.80*E., 41 lks. dist.,

Marked T 21 S R 8 W S 1 B T

Fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S.82*E., 49 lks. dist.,

Marked T 21 S R 8 W S 12 B T

Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.71*W., 95 lks. dist.,
