East, on Random line between secs 26 & 35

80.10 Intersect N. & S. line, 20 lks. south of cor. to secs.

25, 26-35, 36 thence

S.89*51', West, on true line between sec. 26 & 35

Alder, 4 ins. diam., bears N.42*E., 15 lks. dist.,
