16.00 Descend

39.55 Set post 6 ins. diam., 4 ft. long with marked stone 12 ins. in ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on W face from which:

Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.24\*W., 39 lks. dist.,  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T

Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.22\*E., 26 lks. dist.,  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T

56.50 Creek, 40 lks. wide flows NE

79.55 The cor. to secs. 4, 5, 8 & 9

Land rough

Soil, 3rd. rate

Timber, scattering Fir and Cedar

Thick undergrowth of young Alder and Sallal--79.55 chs.

From the cor. to secs. 32 & 33 S bound of town I run W 80 chs. and set a post 6 ins. diam., 4 ft. long on mound of stone 18 ins. high, 3 ft. sq. at base for cor. to secs. 31 & 32, marked T 21 S, S 32 on NE, T 22 S, R 8 W, S 5 on SE, S 6 on SW, S 31 on NW face with one notch on W and 5 on E edge.

12.00 Cross Creek, 20 lks. wide flows W--Ascend

40.00 Set post 4 ins. diam., 4 ft. long with marked stone 12 ins. in ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on W face from which:

Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.57\*E., 26 lks. dist.,  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T

Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.60\*W., 5 lks. dist.,  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T
