A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.49*45'W., 72 lks.
dist., marked T 21 S R 10 W S 24 B T.

Land, broken and mountainous 80.00 chs.

Soil, 2nd rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, hemlock and cedar 80.00 chs.

Dense undergrowth of vine maple, thimble berry, hemlock,
rhododendron, mountain balm, hazel and arrow-wood.
