A maple, 7 ins. diam., bears S.11*15'W., 19 lks.
dist. marked T 21 S R 10 W S 12 B T.

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears N.67*15'W., 25 lks.
dist., marked T 21 S R 10 W S 1 B T.

Note: this corner sets just above a large fir log, lying
along the hill side nearly E. and W.

Land, mountainous 80.00 chs.

Soil, 1st and 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, alder, cedar and maple.

Dense Undergrowth of thimbleberry, salmon-berry, fir,
hemlock, vine maple and arrow-wood. 80.00 chs.
