Closing cor. to T. 21 S Rgs. 9 and 10 W. marked
W C C T 21 S on the S, R 9 W S 6 on the E, and
R 10 W S 1 on the W. faces with 6 grooves on the S,
E, and W faces, from which

A cedar, 40 ins. diam., bears S.42*E., 70 lks.
dist. marked T 21 S R 9 W S 6 B T.

A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears S.89*W., 97 lks.
dist., marked T 21 S R 10 W S 6 B T.

A cedar, 45 ins. diam., bears N.38*W., 33 lks.
dist., marked W C C T 21 S R 9 and 10 W B.T.

Thence I run N.70*W. along the left bank of river 3.66
chs. intersecting S. bdy. of T 20 S 18.00 chs. E. of
cor. to Tp. 20 S Rgs. 9 and 10 W, marking the whole
length of line on W. bdy. of secs. 6 109.45 chs. and
distance of intersection 21.44 chs. E. of cor. to
T 20 S R 9 and 10 W, which is a cedar post, 30 ins.
above ground, and 4 ins. sq., on steep hill side
sloping nearly North, marked T 20 S S 31 on the NE,
R 9 W S 6 on the SE, T 21 S S 1 on the SW, and
R 10 W S 36 on the NW faces with 6 notches on the N,
E, S, and W edges.
