Soil, 1st, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and alder.

Dense undergrowth of thimbleberry, vine maple, fir,
hemlock, brake, salalberry, hazel and arrow-wood
109.45 chs.

September 1, 1894.

12 miles 29 chs. and 45 lks. of these lines run over
mountainous lands or through heavy timber or dense
undergrowth.

Subdivisions of T. 21 S., R. 9 W., same deputy and
contract.

I commenced at the cor. to secs. 35 and 36 on the S.
bdy. of Tp. which I established myself as particularly
described in the field notes of the exterior bdy. of
this Township.

Thence I run N. 00°01' W. bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Va. 20°E.

Descend along ridge.

8.00 Top of ridge descend abruptly.
