Set fir post 5 ft. long 6 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground on hill side sloping West for Closing Cor. to Secs. 24 and 25 Marked C C T 21 S on the W, R 9 W S 25 on the S, and S 24 on the N. faces with 2 grooves on the S. and 4 grooves on the N. sides, from which

A Fir, 12 ins. diam. bears N.80\*E., 96 lks. dist.

Marked C C T 21 S R 9 W S 24 and 25 B T

A Fir, 40 ins. diam. bears N.50\*W., 56 lks. dist.

Marked T 21 S R 9 W S 24 B T

A Fir, 48 ins. diam. bears S.69\*W., 156 lks. dist.

Marked T 21 S R 9 W S 25 B T
