1.75	Summit of ridge, Course S.80°E., N.80°W.	+50
	Descend	
16.25	Creek, 12 lks. wide, Course S.80°E.	-150
19.75	Creek, 8 lks. wide, Course S.70°E.	
30.00	Leave green timber and enter old burn.	
40.00	Set fir post, 4½ ft. long, 6 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground on flat for ¼ Sec. Cor., from which A d. fir, 52 ins. diam. bears N.70°E., 120 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S. B T. A d. fir, 30 ins. diam. bears S.65°W., 43 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S. B T.	
	Ascend gradually.	
55.75	Enter alder thicket.	
69.30	Trail, Course N., 70°E., S.70°W., and leave alder thicket.	
78.25	Top of ridge, Course East and West	+150
80.00	Set alder post, 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground on steep hill side, sloping North for Cor. to Secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, marked T 21 S S 3 on the NE., R 9 W S 10 on the SE., S 9 on the SW., and S 4 on the NW. faces with 5 notches on the S. and 3 notches on the E. edges, from which A fir, 36 ins. diam. bears N.12°30'E., 290 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 9 W S 3 B T. A fir, 80 ins. diam. bears S.82°30'E., 260 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 9 W S 10 B T. An alder, 6 ins. diam. bears S.70°W., 77 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 9 W S 9 B T. A fir, 30 ins. diam. bears N.13°30'W., 225 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 9 W S 4 B T.	
	Land, mountainous 80.00 chs.	
	Soil, 2nd rate.	
	Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple and cherry.	
	Dense undergrowth of thimble, salal and salmon berry, willow, fir and hemlock 80.00 chs.
