40.00 Set fir post 5 ft. long, 5 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground on hill side sloping SE. for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., from whichA fir, 36 ins. diam. bears N.48\*E., 37 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.A fir, 40 ins. diam. bears N.44\*W., 129 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

41.00 Pass over spur Course SE

46.25 Creek, 1 lk. wide, Course S.30\*E.

56.75 Creek, 4 lks. wide, Course S.30\*E.

68.86 A fir, 30 ins. diam., a line tree marked with 2 notches on the N. and S. sides.

80.00 Set fir post  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground on hill side sloping SE. for Cor. to Secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Marked T 21 S S 29 on the NE, R 9 W S 32 on the SE., S 31 on the SW., and S 30 on the NW. faces with 1 notch on the S. and 5 notches on the E. edges, from which,
