Set alder post, 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground on steep hill side sloping NE. for Cor. to Secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18 marked T 21 S S 8 on the NE., R 9 W S 17 on the SE., S 18 on the SW., and S 7 on the NW. faces with 4 notches on the S. and 5 notches on the E. edges, from which

A d. fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.58*E., 156 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 9 W S 8 B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.61*E., 133 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 9 W S 17 B T.

An alder, 6 ins. diam., bears S.79*W., 88 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 9 W S 18 B T.

An alder, 6 ins. diam. bears N.75*W., 244 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 9 W S 7 B T.

Land, mountainous. 80.00 chs.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Timber, dead fir.

Dense undergrowth of thimbleberry, fir, alder, hemlock, willow, fern and black berry 80.00 chs.
