


## Resurvey East Boundary, T. 21 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS	<p>Land, mountainous.</p> <p>Soil, sandy loam, sandstone bedrock, mostly shallow; 2nd rate.</p> <p>Timber, fir, hemlock and cedar.</p> <p>Undergrowth, salmonberry, huckleberry, vinemaple and salal.</p>
	<p>N.0°19'E., resurveying the E. bdy. of sec. 24.</p> <p>Ascend SE. slope, through heavy timber and scattering undergrowth, 160 ft. to</p>
13.51	<p>Intersect the point for old <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor., located by reference to the bearing trees. I obliterate marks on the bearing tree referring to sec. 24 and change this cor. to refer to sec. 19 only. At the exact cor. point set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of sec. 19 only, with brass cap marked</p>

	<p>Ascend SE. slope 80 ft. to ridge.</p>
7.20	<p>Trail, bears NE. and SW.</p>
7.70	<p>Summit of ridge, bears NE. and SW.; descend N. slope 560 ft. to</p>
24.10	<p>Stream, 2 lks. wide, course NW.; ascend SW. slope 60 ft. to</p>
26.49	<p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of sec. 24 only, with brass</p>
