	South, on a true line between Secs. 4 and 5.
39.80	Set post for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner from which An Alder, 4 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 8 lks. dist. An Alder, 12 ins. diam., bears N.55*W., 144 lks. dist.
50.35	Smith River, 2.86 chs. wide, and set meander post, from which A Chittenwood, 9 ins. diam., bears N.42*W., 15 lks. dist. A Vinemaple, 4 ins. diam., bears N.68*E., 53 lks. dist.
53.21	Set meander post on left bank, from which A Vinemaple, 4 ins. diam., bears N.15*W., 4 lks. dist. An Alder, 15 ins. diam., bears S.50*E., 8 lks. dist.
69.00	Creek 60 lks. wide, runs NE.
77.50	Creek 60 lks. wide, runs NW.
79.80	The corner to Secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9. Land, rough and broken. Soil, 2nd rate. On the creeks and river bottoms the soil is 1st rate. Timber, Hemlock, Fir and Alder. Dense undergrowth of Vinemaple, Salal Bush and small Hemlock.

80.00	Set stone 26X14X6 for corner to Secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8. Land, very broken.
