Resurvey Portion West Bdy., T. 21 S., R. 10 W.

Retracements

From the closing cor. of Tps. 21 S., Rs. 10 and 11 W. North retracing the W. bdrs. of Secs. 31, 30 and 19, making careful and protracted search at 80.00 chs. and each 40.00 chs. interval thereafter for old cors., finding no evidence thereof, and at 240.63 chs. fall 40 lks. E of the cor. of Secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24. The course and length of this line is N.0°06'W., 240.63 chs.

North, retracing the W. bdy. of Sec. 18; at 40.00 chs. no trace of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. cor., set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. and at 81.07 chs. fall 127 lks. E of the cor. of Secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18. The length and course of this line is N.0°54'W., 81.07 chs.

North, retracing the W bdy. of Sec. 7; at 40.00 chs. find no trace of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. cor., set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. and at 81.82 chs. fall 5 lks. E. of the cor. of Secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12. The length and course of this line is N.0°02'W., 81.83 chs.

From the closing cor. of Tps. 21 S., Rs. 10 and 11 W.

N.0°06'W., resurveying the W. bdy. of Sec. 31.

Ascend SE slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, 190 ft. to

24.30 Top of spur, slopes E; descend NE slope 515 ft. to creek,

45.42 Intersect bdy. of H.E.S. No. 130, S.36°54'E., 0.84 chs.

from cor. No. 21, which is a stone, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

45.60 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE; ascend SE slope 25 ft. to

46.75 Top of spur, slopes E; descend NE slope 30 ft. to

48.72 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. cor. of Sec. 31 only, with brass cap marked
