CHAINS

Land, mountainous.

Soil, shallow sandy loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock and Cedar.

Undergrowth, Vinemaple, Salmonberry and Salal.

N.0°02'W., resurveying the line bet. Secs. 7 and 12.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 1.00 Murphy Creek, 15 lks. wide, course N.15°E; along E slope.
 6.50 Ravine, course E; ascend SE slope 300 ft. to
 16.00 Top of spur, slopes E; descend NE slope 60 ft. to
 19.10 Ravine, course E; ascend SE slope 220 ft. to
 25.40 Top of spur, slopes E; descend NE slope 480 ft. to
 40.90 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course E; ascend.
 40.91 Point for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. falls in creek.
 40.99 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for witness corner to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner, with brass cap marked
