CHAINS

Undergrowth, Huckleberry, Salmonberry, Vinemaple, Manzanita, Alder, Salal and Rhododendron.

From the corner of Secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26.

North, on sectional guide meridian, bet. Secs. 23 and 24.

Ascend SW slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, 230 ft. to

- 6.20 Top of spur, slopes W; descend NW slope 135 ft. to
- 11.30 Ravine, course W; ascend SW slope 480 ft. to
- 21.50 Top of spur, slopes W; descend NW slope 535 ft. to
- 35.10 Small stream, 2 lks. wide, course NW; ascend broken SW slope 15 ft. to
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., with brass cap marked

- 71.10 Ravine, course W; ascend SW slope 100 ft. to
- 77.00 Top of small spur, slopes W; descend NW slope 170 ft. to
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, with brass cap marked
